Fringe Benefits for Faculty and Classified include: FICA, Retirement, Group Insurance, Health Insurance, Unemployment Compensation, Workers' Compensation, Faculty-Staff Tuition Waivers, Short-Term Disability, Leave Balances Upon Separation, Disability Insurance, VRS Long-term Disability, and Cash Match Plan.

Fringe Benefits for Hourly include: FICA, Unemployment Compensation, and Workers' Compensation.

Equipment means an article of nonexpendable and tangible personal property having a useful life of more than one year and an acquisition cost of \$5,000 or more per unit.

SECTION III: GENERAL

A. <u>LIMITATIONS</u>:

The rates in this Agreement are subject to any statutory or administrative limitations and apply to a given grant, contract or other agreement only to the extent that funds are available. Acceptance of the rates is subject to the following conditions: (1) Only costs incurred by the organization were included in its facilities and administrative cost principles; (2) The same costs are legal obligations of the organization and are allowable under the governing cost costs; (3) Similar types of costs have been treated as facilities and administrative costs are not claimed as direct the organization which was used to establish the rates is not later found to be materially incomplete or inaccurate by the Government. In such situations the rate(s) would be subject to renegotiation at the discretion of the Federal

B. ACCOUNTING CHANGES:
